



Dear PJCC Community Members:

San Mateo County Department of Health has issued a [shelter in place order](#) effective at midnight. Other neighboring Bay Area counties are doing the same. This order requires that other than obtaining health care and necessary supplies, or providing aid to family and friends, all residents are required to remain at home.

**This means that the PJCC will remain closed until at least Tuesday, April 7.**
