

PJCC MindBody Account Login


Your MindBody account is automatically set up when you become a member of the center. If you've never used this program for registrations in our center you will want to follow these next couple of steps. DO NOT create an account as the duplicate will stop you from being able to register.

FIRST TIME MINDBODY USER: DESKTOP

1. Click the need new password located in the bottom left.

You will receive an email that will allow you to create your new password.
